



CAMPING OPERATING REGULATIONS

1. To enter the premises, you must first register your details at reception.
2. You can register with your ID card, passport, or other legal document, or with an official camping card.
3. Unaccompanied minors (under 14 years of age) are not accepted unless accompanied by their guardian throughout their stay.
4. Departures must take place by 12:00 noon (otherwise you will be charged for a half-day stay).
5. Please inform the reception desk one day before your departure.
6. Do not change your pitch without informing the reception desk and obtaining their consent.
7. The management reserves the right to refuse to rent a spot or to terminate your stay if deemed necessary.
8. In case of departure earlier than the agreed date, **for any reason**, the charge will apply for the entire duration of the reservation.
9. Do not fence or dig your pitches, as this may be dangerous.
10. Do not use charcoal grills; a special area is provided by the campsite.
11. Quiet hours: 15:00 – 17:00 and 23:00 – 08:00.
12. Audio devices should be used at low volume.
13. The maximum driving speed within the campsite is 5km/h.
14. Do not wash your vehicles within the campsite.
15. Empty chemical toilets exclusively in the designated areas marked CH.

16. Please accompany your children to the restrooms.
17. Pool hours: 08:00 – 20:00 (under the supervision of a certified lifeguard).
18. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult to enter the pool.
19. Pets are always welcome on a leash and accompanied by their guardian. Pets entering the campsite must have an up-to-date health record book that includes the required medical procedures (vaccinations, deworming, etc.). The collection of their waste is the sole responsibility of their guardians and must be done formally and strictly.
20. Items placed in common areas are the responsibility of each camper. Campers are responsible for their own belongings and camping equipment in general. The management is not responsible for any damage (caused by other campers, falling trees, weather conditions), loss, or theft.
21. When campers leave their campsite, the site and the surrounding area must be clean, with no rubbish or other objects left behind.

Entering and staying at the campsite means automatic acceptance of the rules. If a camper does not respect their fellow campers in any way, or causes disruption or does not comply with the regulations, the management reserves the right to remove them.
